#### **Specialty Lighting**



Switch to durable LED bulbs and save energy and money

- Promotes adoption of Specialty ENERGY STAR LED bulbs through statewide retail locations and the Georgia Power Marketplace
- Active in more than 80

 Georgia Power Residential Customers

- Assists Georgia Power residential customers with daily energy usage
- Incentives between \$0.40 - \$2.40 depending on bulb type

- Standard LEDs
- Specialty LEDs –
  Globes, Candelabras
- Reflector LEDs i.e., recessed can lights

#### **Home Energy Improvement Program (HEIP)**



Maintain comfort with qualifying energy-saving improvements

- Promotes whole-house or individual improvement approach for customers in existing homes
- Rebates from \$575 up to \$1,150 depending on single family or multifamily

Program Details



 Georgia Power residential customers living in an existing single family or multifamily residence

**Participants** 



 Reduce energy use, save on utility costs, improve indoor air quality and improve comfort

Program Benefits

- Individual Improvements: Attic insulation, Duct sealing, Air sealing, Heat pump water heater, Smart tstats
- Whole House: Holistic improvements including a Home Energy Assessment to achieve at least 25% overall electricity savings

### Smart thermostat rebates up to \$38 from georgiapowermarketplace.com

#### **Whole House**

- Home Energy Assessment rebate 50% of cost up to \$75
- Whole House improvements rebate 50% of cost up to \$500

### Smart thermostat rebates up to \$75 from georgiapowermarketplace.com

#### Whole House

- Home Energy Assessment rebate 50% of cost up to \$150
- Whole House improvements rebate 50% of cost up to \$1000

#### **Individual Improvements**

- Attic insulation rebate 50% of cost up to \$250
- Duct sealing rebate 50% of cost up to \$300
- Heat pump water heater rebate 50% of cost up to \$250

#### **Refrigerator Recycling**



Maintain comfort with qualifying energy-saving improvements

- Residential customers are eligible for free pickup and recycling of secondary refrigerators or freezers
- Eligible customers receive a \$35 rebate

 Georgia Power single family residential customers are eligible

- Assists Georgia Power residential customers with energy usage
- Customers who dispose of spare inefficient refrigerators and freezers can save up to \$100 per year

#### Temp√ Energy Management Program



Use energy more efficiently and keep costs low for our community

- Shifts electricity usage during peak demand periods through smart thermostats
- Eligible customers receive \$50 incentive

- Eligible residential single family and multifamily customers
- Offer limited to allelectric heat pump customers

 Assists customers in achieving summer and winter peak demand and energy savings

- Georgia Power customers can purchase rebated smart thermostats on Marketplace
- Customers can register their own eligible thermostat

#### **HopeWorks: Seniors Assistance Program**



#### Free home energy improvements for income-qualified seniors

- Assists income-qualified seniors with home energy improvements
- Georgia Power provides up to \$4000 in funding per residence for qualified program participants

- 60+ years of age
- Georgia Power customer must own and be living in the home
- Household income is 200% or less of current U.S. Federal Poverty Guidelines
- Free in-home audit and energy efficiency upgrades
- Assists Georgia Power residential customers with management of daily energy usage

- Air Sealing
- Attic Insulation
- Duct Sealing
- LED Lighting
- HVAC Repair
- Floor Insulation

#### **Home Energy Efficiency Assistance Program (HEEAP)**



Free home energy improvements for income-qualified customers

- Assists income-qualified residential customers with home energy improvements
- Provides up to \$3,750 in funding per residence for qualified program participants
- Georgia Power customer living in single family or multifamily residence
- Household income is 200% or less of current U.S. Federal Poverty Guidelines

 To help increase the number of people that can be served by this program, members of the community can donate funds that will be added to the funding provided by Georgia Power

- Attic Insulation
- Duct Sealing
- LED Lighting
- HVAC Repair
- Water Heater Jackets
- Smart Thermostats
- Pipe Wrap Insulation
